





15.2 Supporting Land Ecosystems through Education

15.2.1 Promoting Land Conservation through Supportive Events

USU is committed in supporting conservation programs and sustainable land use, including the protection of forests and wild lands. This commitment demonstrates through the implementation of various events and activities that support the themes of conservation and sustainable land management. In 2022, USU has carried out activities grouped into several groups such as: (a) Conferences, (b) Public Lectures, (c) Workshops and others. USU also carries out several summer course activities with student participants from within and outside the country. One of the summer course topics implemented by USU is "Inclusive and Sustainable Palm Oil Industry" where topics related to deforestation and certification in the palm oil industry are discussed. Apart from that, USU also remains committed to continuing virtual workshop activities with the theme sustainable palm oil landscape. This workshop was carried out with the aim of changing the behaviour and awareness of young people towards the concept of sustainability. In 2022, 45 participants from 7 countries have attended the workshop. The topics discussed were deforestation and certification in the sustainable palm oil supply chain. USU organized those activities in collaboration with various partners from local and international.
